RE-STATED FISHING POLICY

12.02.2019

The Board Minutes from the October 12th, 2017 meeting are very clear and, while the current board is sympathetic to Mr. Witkin, no deviation will be granted at this time. To re-iterate, the full fishing resolution reads as follows:

On October 12, 2017, the UPCA Board of Directors approved a formal Fishing Policy for all bodies of water within the boundaries of University Park Country Club and the residential neighborhoods.

In accordance with the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions and as approved by the board,

**FISHING IS NOT PERMITTED ANYWHERE IN
UNIVERSITY PARK AT ANY TIME BY ANYONE.**

This formal Policy supersedes any guidance or understanding that may have circulated in the past. This 'NO EXCEPTIONS' policy includes residents (and their guests) fishing from their property directly adjacent to a pond.

Your strict adherence to this Policy is appreciated.

Laurie Evans inquired about the board's expectation of enforcement and it was suggested that management should enforce the policy by whatever reasonable means deemed necessary.
